

In 2025, the Roscongress International Platform operated a new thematic and networking area at the St. Petersburg International Economic Forum (SPIEF) – **the Roscongress International Cooperation Area.** It is designed to be a single communication space for dialogue among representatives of the Russian and foreign government and public institutions, business circles, expert communities, international organizations, and integration associations.

RESULTS OF ROSCONGRESS INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION AREA AT SPIEF 2025





During SPIEF 2025, the following took place at the Roscongress International Cooperation Area:

- twelve thematic events including investment presentations, themed discussions, expert lectures, a Ted Talk, and South African wine tasting;
- discussions about the current state of and prospects for international business, investment, trade, economic, cultural, humanitarian, technological, and media cooperation;
- the signing of 21 cooperation agreements between the Roscongress Foundation and business associations, chambers of commerce, business structures and alliances, educational institutions, public organizations in Russia and abroad and their associations, and Russia's regions.

THE TV BRICS TELEVISION STUDIO AT SPIEF 2025





A joint media project from the Roscongress International Platform and the TV BRICS International Media Network was implemented at the Roscongress International Cooperation Area at SPIEF 2025. Its central element was the TV BRICS television studio.

The results of its work include:

- 25+ videos on international business cooperation
- A true mix of ideas: the TV BRICS studio brings together the voices of 26 professionals from different fields and continents
- Global reach: interviews are available in six languages (Russian, English, Chinese, Portuguese, Spanish, and Arabic)
 on the TV BRICS portal and are promoted by TV BRICS media partners around the world. The total audience coverage
 of TV BRICS materials about SPIEF in foreign media totalled more than 600 million users.
